Poised Poodle's Agreement & Health Guarantee

Thank you for deciding to purchase one of our puppies. We want to make this a stress free enjoyable experience for you. Please feel free to email me or message me with any questions or concerns that you might have along the way. We will keep you up to date with information about your puppy as it grows until it is time for your puppy to go to its new home.

Purchase Agreement

- 1. By putting a deposit on a puppy, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions within this contract.
- 2. We require a non-refundable holding fee of \$500 to hold the puppy of your choice. This holding fee will go toward the total price of the puppy.
- 3. This holding fee is non-refundable, unless there is a problem with the health of your puppy. In that case, the buyer will have their choice of a full refund or of transferring that holding fee towards another puppy.
- 4. If for any reason the buyer must rehome the dog at any point, he/she will return the dog to Poised Poodles with no refund unless discussed and okayed with Poised Poodles to rehome the dog with a family member or friend.
- 5. Our puppies are sold as PET ONLY with limited registration (No Breeding Rights) unless specified and agreed upon by the breeder. If sold on limited registration they may NOT be used for breeding. It is healthiest to spay/ neuter a dog not being bred. Please wait until at least 6 months of age. If you alter your dog before 6 months of age the health guarantee will be void. Early spay/ neuter can be detrimental to your dog's health as they need appropriate amounts of hormones to develop properly.
- **Please be certain that you are ready for the time commitment and financial responsibility of a puppy prior to putting a deposit on one. **

Health Guarantee

1. It will be up to us, the breeders, to decide when the puppy will be ready to go to its new home. Usually at the age of 8 weeks, depending on the weight of the puppy and how easily it is weaned from the mother. We will not, under any circumstances, let the puppy leave before it is ready.

- 2. The puppy will be up to date on shots and worming at the time of pickup of the puppy. It is very important that you continue the vaccinations and worming. Please do not expose your puppy to high traffic dog areas (pet stores, dog parks, etc.) until he/she has completed the entire vaccination schedule around 18-20 weeks old. You can still expose your puppy to new places and people, we encourage you to. Just do it safely.
- 3. The puppy will have been vet checked and deemed in good health at the time of sale.
- 4. If within 3 days, a licensed vet finds the puppy to be unhealthy or unfit for sale, the puppy may be returned for a full refund provided the puppy has not been injured or neglected. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming the puppy "unhealthy for purchase".
- 5. This guarantee does not cover any health issues caused by neglect or injury from the buyer.
- 6. This guarantee does not include minor illnesses and health issues such as colds (kennel cough), allergies, incorrect bites, internal or external parasites or umbilical hernias. However, the breeder will disclose any known illnesses or health issues prior to the sale. We will have a wellness exam at their first vet visit around 7 weeks of age and make the buyer aware of any abnormalities if they are present. If abnormalities are present, you will have the choice to keep your puppy, a refund, or to move your deposit to another puppy if available.
- 7. The breeder cannot assume responsibility for this puppy after 72 hours of the sale. It is the responsibility of the buyer to care for the puppy properly and keep it free from harm. Please remember that your puppy must be treated with great care and protected from danger.
- 8. The breeder assumes no responsibility for any medical expenses incurred after the sale.
- 9. The breeder assumes no responsibility for training difficulties or behavior problems. Although we begin training with the puppies at a very young age, it is the buyer's responsibility to continue training the puppy and continuing proper socialization.
- 10. The breeder does not guarantee size, eye color, weight, or coat color but we can give you our best guess.
- 11. The breeder gives a two year guarantee against any life threatening congenital defects of the puppy. If this should occur then the puppy will be returned to the breeder and the buyer will receive another puppy of the same breed and value when there is one available or a refund. The buyer will have full financial responsibility in returning the puppy to the breeder and must present proof from a licensed veterinarian of this defect. If the puppy passes in your care, a necropsy must be provided from a licensed veterinarian showing the cause of death.
- 12. The puppy/ dog must be fed a quality diet. We start our puppies on EUKANUBA SMALL BREED PUPPY for the first year of their life and use raw bones and single ingredient treats.. Once puppies reach one year of age we recommend you switch them to EUKANUBA SMALL BITES ADULT. We recommend you keep them on this food or a similar quality food for life.

13. We will hold your puppy up to one week beyond the take home date free of charge. Beyond one week, a \$25 per day charge will be incurred. This charge must be paid at 8 weeks of age and discussed beforehand. This charge covers extended care, training, socialization, vaccines, and deworming needed during this time.
